His last adventure, Dan passed away peacefully at home on September 26th, 2025, with his loving wife Marie by his side. Dan was born in Moncton on September 15th, 1930, he was the first-born child of Daniel Sr. and Jessie (Shea) McGee.

Always a gentleman with a tranquil nature, he was an adventurous soul who left home at seventeen and traveled North America, usually via freight train, working as a gandy dancer for numerous railways, a roustabout for Clyde Beatty's Wild Animal Circus, cotton picker, movie extra and anything else that was available and honest.

He enlisted in the Canadian Army at the time of the Korean conflict and served in that theatre as well as numerous postings across Canada and Europe. Retiring from the forces in 1973, he started his profession of Health Inspector for the provinces of New Brunswick and Nova Scotia and as Hygiene Officer, CN/AC Medical Services, Great Lakes Region.

He also was a volunteer of the World University Services Canada as Chief Health Inspector for the Kingdom of Lesotho. Among his many jobs, the most satisfying he thought was while working as crew on a Nova Scotia long liner and was an advocate for the brave hard-working fishermen of the Atlantic region.

Dan was a member of the Riverview Veterans, Dieppe Veterans, Branch #6 of The Royal Canadian Legion, the F.S.N.A., the PROBUS Club of Moncton, Irish Cultural Association of New Brunswick. (1946–2025)
